

PATRIOTIC PICNIC PLATE SET



MATERIALS

CCX151 Coupe Dinner Plate DB21427 Coupe Salad Plate Fan Brush Star Pattern Scissors Straight Pin Gingham 2 Silkscreen Container for Mixing Goo Goo Powders Screen Squeegee

COLORS

CMM 98- Red Head CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon CMM 67 - Snowflake

INSTRUCTIONS

- Star Plate:
 - Paint the top of the plate with one coat of Snowflake using a fan brush.
 - Cut out stars from the paper pattern.
 - Working one at a time dip a star into water and stick it to the plate.
 We concentrated our stars around the edge of the plate using both size stars.
 - Use a fan brush to apply one coat of Snowflake painting right on top of the stars. Allow plate to dry.
 - Paint the top of the plate with 3 coats of Blue Lagoon, painting right on top of the stars.
 - As the paint starts to dry, the background will lose it's shine and the stars will be shiny. This is the point in which we want to remove the stars. To remove the star use a pin to poke about 1/4" from the edge of the paper and scoop the pin upward to release.
- Gingham Plate:
 - Thicken up Red Head paint with Goo Powders until it's the consistency of pudding.
 - Use the squeegee to apply the gingham silkscreen all over the top of the plate.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you a solid color.
- By poking the pin in from the edge of the star you'll avoid scratching up the edges.
- Remove the paper while they're still shiny and the background has lost it's shine.
